Special Rules – RHC "Year End Tournament"

- 1. The home team will enter the game sheets on the Hockey Calgary website and email them to the Division Coordinator ASAP following the completion of each game.
- 2. The home team will supply the timekeeper and a penalty box volunteer. The visiting team will supply the scorekeeper and a penalty box volunteer.
- 3. Game Format is as follows:
 - 1 hour permit 12, 15 & 15 minute stop time periods
 - 1 ¼ hour permit 15, 15 & 15 minute stop time periods
 - 1 ½ hour permit 15, 15 & 20 minute stop time periods

At the first stoppage of play when there is 5 minutes or less left in the permit the time clock will be reset to 2 minutes.

- 4. There is <u>no</u> overtime or shootout in the first 3 round robin games of the tournament ... a tie is a tie.
- 5. 2 points for a win, 0 points for a loss and 1 point for a tie.
- 6. If there is a tie in the accumulated total points after the round robin games the tie breaker is the team with the least amount of penalty minutes, if it is still a tie then it will be goals for and against and last is a coin flip.
- 7. Should the final games (A Final, B Final and C Final) be tied in the last 5 minutes of the permit you go to a shootout (same format as EMHW). Each team is given 3 shots and if it is still tied you go to "Sudden Victory" format. Note: no player may shoot twice until all players have shot once.
- 8. The Home Team has the option to either shoot first or second.
- 9. The Teams shall alternate shots.
- 10. All players are eligible to participate unless they are serving a ten minute misconduct or have been assessed a game misconduct, gross misconduct, match penalty or have been ejected due to the 3 penalties in a game rule.
- 11. There are no presentations at the end of the games.
- 12. Coaches should have skates, helmet and whistle in case no referees show.
